

Guidelines for Self-Portraits

To ensure that we can use your photo in the software we are using to create our directory, here are some simple guidelines and suggestions to get you started.

- Keep the picture close on upper body and faces. If you are a family, standing in a line probably will not look as nice as in rows.
- Please do not add anything to the photo (text or a frame).
- We will most likely need to crop your photo to fit our specified dimensions. So leave a little bit of space around the edges so we don't cut anybody off.
- Take the picture in Landscape (Horizontal) mode.
- Try not to have a big height difference. Use chairs/stools as needed.



Everybody is in a line and it's hard to see faces. And I've added a border. *(doesn't the floor look nice?)*



I have a big difference between tall and short people, it's vertical and I've cut people off on the sides.



Everybody is nice and close, the picture is horizontal and there is some extra room on the sides for cropping *(Scott refused to smile)*
